HEAD:

<u>Shape</u>: Medium to large sized inverted pear. A slightly rounded forehead

Ears: Medium with a wide, deep base and a rounded top. As much on side as on top of the head, slightly tilt outward. Lynx tips are desirable, Thumbprint on backs. Eyes: Deep set medium-sized soft triangle and heavily hooded. Bushy brow. An eye width apart. Gold, Brown or Gooseberry Green

Chin: Strong and fleshy with good depth. Aligns with nose.

<u>Muzzle</u>: Full and broad muzzle with fleshy whisker pads that are gently rounded. Definite whisker break. <u>Nose</u>: Wide with large brick nose leather. slightly convex and slight bump. Chin, muzzle and nose form an equally sided soft diamond.

Profile:; Concave curve from eye ridge to bridge of nose.

BODY:

<u>Torso</u>: Medium to large sized. Substantial and rangy. Prominent shoulder blades. Back not level, slight upward slope toward hips. Hips medium width, prominent, slightly higher than shoulder sloping downward to tail. Deep flank and broad chest. Primordial belly pouch. <u>Legs</u>: Long heavy boned and muscular. The back legs are slightly longer.

<u>Feet</u>: Large, almost round with large fleshy toes. All toes except dew claws must touch the floor pointing forward. <u>Tail</u>: Tail bone must be minimal 2 inches and maximal length to hock when leg extended. Articulated tail desirable, kinks and curls acceptable.

Boning: Heavy.

Musculature: Muscular build.

COAT/COLOR/PATTERN:

Coat, color and pattern, secondary to type. Both coats facial hair is full and bushy, with downward growth pattern. Coat separates easily and is weather resistant.

<u>Length</u> (PB): Short stand-up coat Belly hair longer <u>Length</u> (PBL): Medium, under 2

inches. Belly hair longer.

<u>Texture</u> (PB): Soft and wooly, having loft. Is resilient to the touch.

<u>Texture</u> (PBL): Soft, lying closer to the body than shorthair. Semi-dense.

COLOR: All shades of Brown Spotted Tabby; mouse coat; reversed ticking; light color throat to belly; paw pads/hocks dark brown/black; tail tip should be dark brown/black; white or cream band must surround eye; mascara marking from outer corner down through cheek.

PATTERN: Small to medium spots; muted by ticking; random spotting preferred. Belly must be spotted.

CATEGORY: Traditional. DIVISION: Tabby. COLOR: Brown Spotted

Tabby.

PERMISSIBLE OUTCROSSES: None.

ALLOWANCES: Polydactyl; seven toes maximum. Broken mackerel pattern allowed. Seasonal color changes. White lockets.

PENALIZE:

Belly too dark. Close lying coat (PB). Too long coat(PBL). Deficient chin or brow. Flat head. Lacking primordial belly pouch. Narrow hips. Tail under 2 inches or past the hock. Cow hocking. Poly toes, excluding dew claws, not touching table.

WITHHOLD ALL AWARDS (WW):

Any color/pattern not described. Lack of ticking or pattern throughout coat. Ruff around neck (PBL). Round eyes.Fine boning.

DISQUALIFY (DQ): Tail under 1 inch or full length tail.
